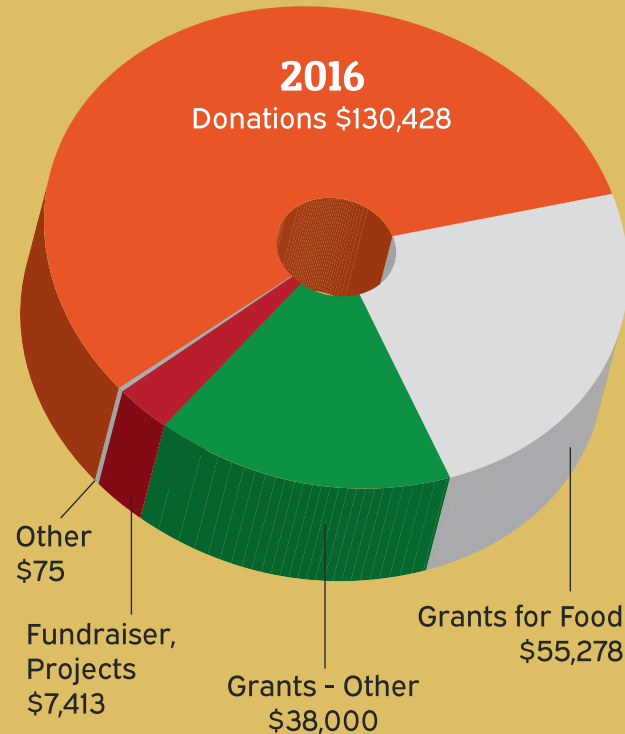
Our Mission
